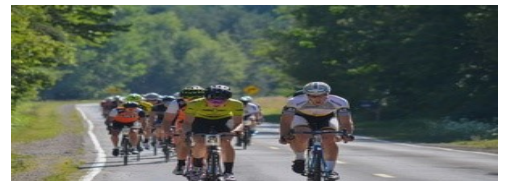
Many people take advantage of the paved trail to the fishing pond and enjoy the quiet area amongst the old apple orchard.
